<u>State Conference</u> is usually attended by all members. If you have been actively involved all year, we will make sure you are on a team or have a competition. This is how you learn!

<u>National Conference</u> is usually attended by 75% of those that compete at State. You must place in the top 4 and you can only compete in one event, which requires us to often add people to qualifying teams.
