

Changing the Mobile App to Skyward Qmlativ

Post migration, users must change their Skyward Mobile App to use the Skyward Qmlativ database. This tip sheet should help users accomplish that task.

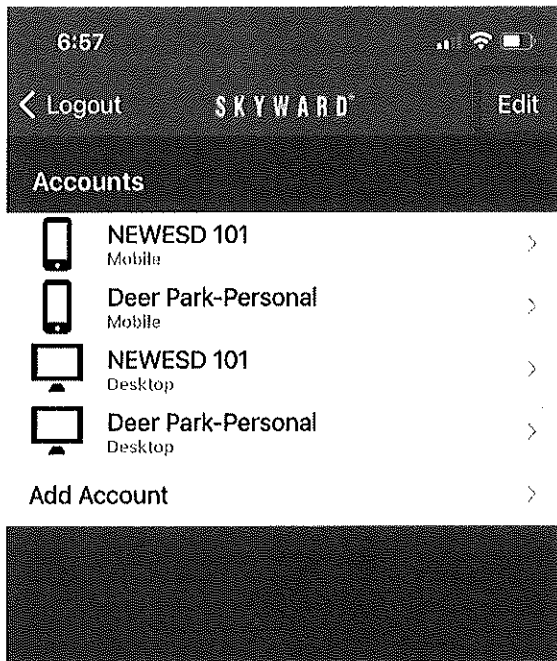
Users will need to access their Skyward Mobile App on their device.

Deleting the Skyward SMS Account

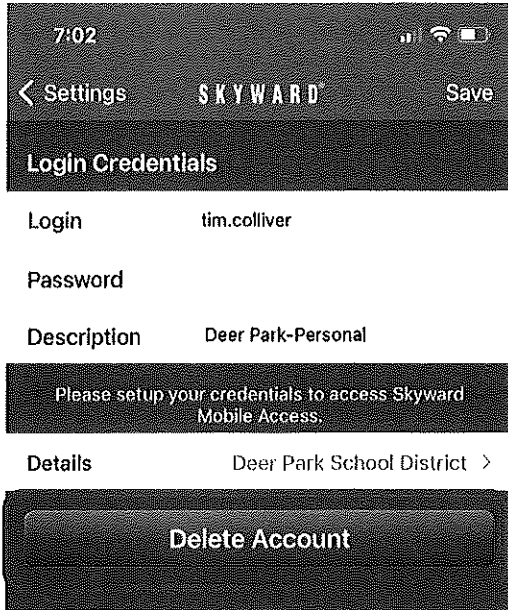
Users will need to access their existing Accounts by logging on to the Skyward Mobile App.

From the Accounts screen, click the Edit button.



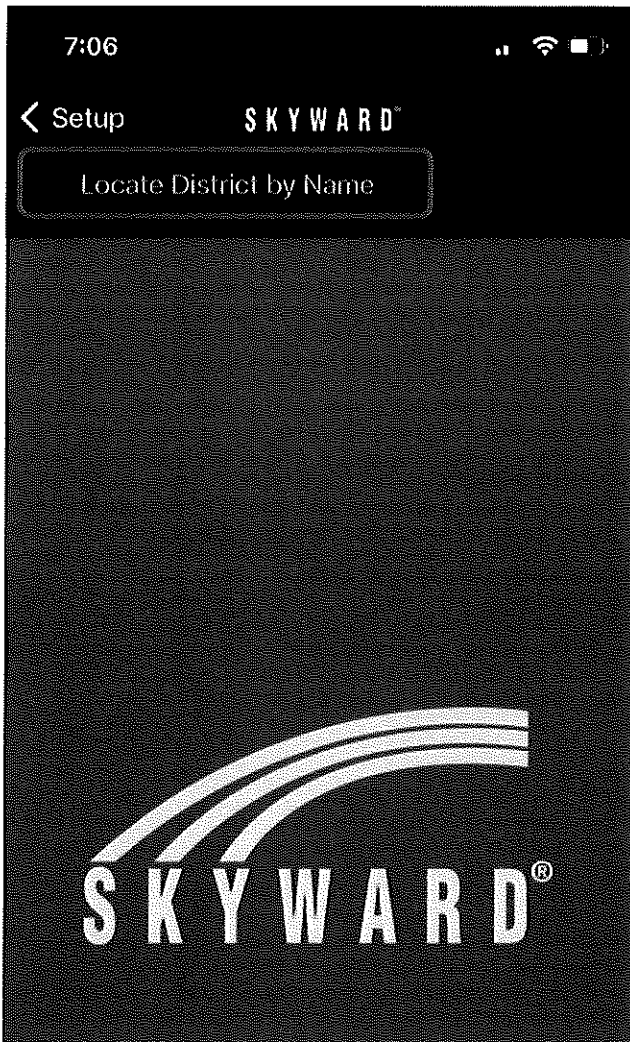
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From the Login Credentials screen, click Delete Account
